Dear Mayor and City Commissioners:

Status Report COVID-19

The City of Rio Hondo and the Rio Hondo Independent School District had a successful second dose clinic. This coming Thursday the City and the School will have another clinic for all 18 and over who wish to be immunized.

The City of Rio Hondo is continuing with curb-side meals for the elderly. In the next few weeks. The city will receive fifty percent of the American Rescue Plan allocation. The total allocation is \$590, 231.35 for covid related expenses or infrastructure. The city did receive the \$110,000 from the state for covid related expenses. We are continuing to submit expenses to FEMA. The City submitted a second application for \$131,000 for Police Station renovations.

Staffing

The Stone Garden funding has been approved and staff will begin that work. The City is searching for two licensed water and sewer operators and 2 laborers.

Streets

The Mesquite Street reconstruction by Rhyner Construction is continuing. Public works will begin with the pot hole program next week. The city will dedicate resources and staff for this project.

Apartments

The Mayor and City Administrator visited with the owner of new apartments on Wednesday of this week. The project will be completed by April 30, 2021 and the retention pond is done. Staff will monitor the landscaping on FM 106 (Colorado Blvd.). In May city staff and owners will do a final review of the site for approval.

The city will enforce no parking in front of the Riverside Village Apartments, because of safety concerns and persons putting trash on the ground.

Facilities

Both the City Water Plant and the Sewer plant are in good working order. The Library continues to receive patrons. We are working on repairing the roof, new LED lighting and other electrical repairs for the Library.

Attached for your review, is our latest sales tax funds, for the month of March in the amount of \$23,088.66.



RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2) strictly prohibits peace officers employed by the <u>RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT.</u> from engaging in racial profiling;
- 3) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the <u>RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT</u>, if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the <u>RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT</u>, has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the <u>RIO HONDO</u> <u>POLICE DEPT.</u> who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the <u>RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT.</u> policy;
- 6) requires collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a warning or citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
 - a. the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
 - b. whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search;
 - c. whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual;
 - d. whether the peace officer used physical force that resulted in bodily injury during the stop;
 - e. the location of the stop;
 - f. the reason for the stop.
- 7) requires the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:
 - a. the Commission on Law Enforcement; and
 - b. the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

The RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. has satisfied the statutory data audit requirements as prescribed in Article 2.133(c),

Code of Criminal Procedure during the reporting period.
